Camp Hours: Monday through Friday; 7:15am—6:00 pm

Camp Open House: Monday, June 7th; 6:30 – 7:30pm

Weekly Costs: \$115 a week for Members; \$135 a week for the general public
(includes all trips, activities, supervision, and 2 snacks a day)

Registration Fee: \$30 for 1st child and \$15 for each additional child in family
(not included in weekly cost; paid one time for entire Summer)

Deposits: \$15 deposit per week / per child
(included in weekly cost; will hold you a space for each week)

Please Note: The registration fee of \$30 and a \$15 deposit per week per child is due upon registration of your child(ren) for the summer camp program. **Deposit(s) are non-refundable & non-transferable.**

Weekly balances are due the Friday before each week of camp.

Parent / Guardian is responsible for balance due of each week registered unless a 7 day's written notice of cancellation has been received by the YMCA Membership Office (or front desk).

****THEMES MAY OR MAY NOT NECESSARILY COINCIDE WITH SCHEDULED FIELD TRIPS**

IMPORTANT CAMP INFORMATION:

- ◆ Every Day of Summer Camp will include physical activity (both inside and outside the building). All campers should wear close-toed shoes (sneakers) for camp each day.
- ◆ Weather permitting, all campers will have 'park days' on Mondays and Fridays of each week. Please be sure to pack plenty of sunscreen and sun protection on these days!
- ◆ Field trips are scheduled for Wednesday of each week. All Campers should wear their daycamp T-shirt on Field Trip days.
- ◆ Children are scheduled to swim nearly every day. Please be sure to have your child(ren) bring a swimsuit and towel with them each day at camp. All children will be swim tested weekly to determine their swimming ability. Non-swimmers are encouraged to bring a lifejacket for use in the pool. If you are unable to provide a lifejacket for a non-swimming child, a community lifejacket will be provided for use in the pool.
- ◆ Be sure to have your child(ren) bring a packed lunch (with plenty to drink) every day. A light snack will be provided every day at 9:30am and 3:30pm. Lunches and snacks can be refrigerated, but not cooked or re-heated, or otherwise prepared.
- ◆ Campers will not have access to the snack machines or juice bar facilities while at Camp. Campers should not bring money with them to camp (with the exception of Field Trip days, at which point a small amount of cash is permissible and optional for souvenirs),
- ◆ Be sure to clearly label all your child(ren)'s belongings.
- ◆ Group ratios are arranged and defined as:
LEMON ANTS (6 and 7 year olds): 1:9 Counselor to Camper Ratio
LEAF CUTTER ANTS (8 and 9 year olds): 1:10 Counselor to Camper Ratio
FIRE ANTS (10, 11, and 12 year olds): 1:12 Counselor to Camper Ratio
- ◆ Balance of each week's payment is due on the **FRIDAY BEFORE** your child(ren) will be attending. You may pay in advance for future weeks you have your child registered for.
- ◆ **Please note that you are required to give a 7 days written notice in order to cancel a week your child(ren) is registered for. If you do so, you will not be responsible for the week you cancelled, but please note the deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable.**
- ◆ An 'authorization to give medication form' **MUST** be completed by the parent (guardian) if your child requires medication to be administered while at the program. Medicine **MUST** be in the original container. Please give specific written instructions regarding dosage of any medicine.
- ◆ All children need to be picked up from camp **no later than 6:00 PM**. For every 10 minutes your child is picked up after 6:00 PM, there will be a **\$10 late fee per child**.
- ◆ Full Payment must be made the **Friday BEFORE the week(s)** your child(ren) is attending, or there will be a **\$10 late fee** applied per child to that week's balance. If payment is not received by **7:00 AM the following Monday**, your child(ren) will not be permitted to attend that week or any future weeks until that balance is paid in full.
- ◆ The YMCA encourages an atmosphere of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility. Any inappropriate behavior or repeated disciplinary action may result in your child being dismissed from the program for a day, week, or even the remainder of the summer.
- ◆ If your child has any the following, you need to keep him or her home from camp (or you will be required to pick your child up):
~**A Temperature of 100° or more, any contagious illness, vomiting, or diarrhea.**
